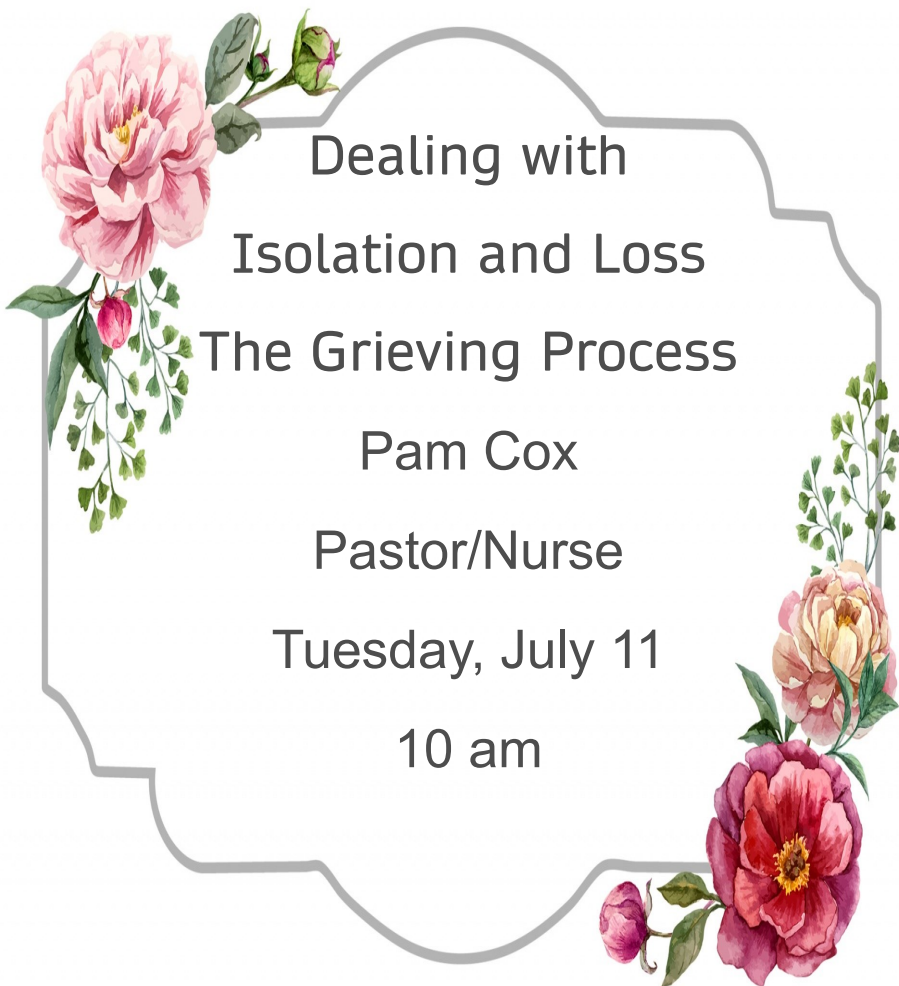




## Lunch Wallet

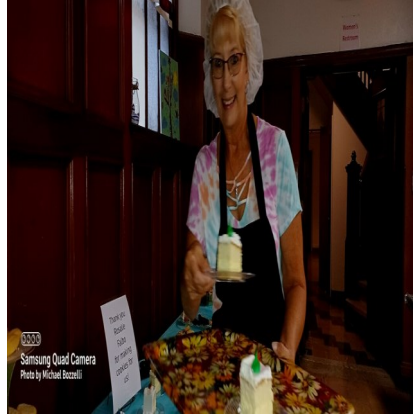
